Hi Erik,

I do not have a copy of the SLN for Hops so I'm not sure if it is for the exact same use as what's on the label:

HOPS: For control of Mites and Powdery Mildew: Use 1– 2 gallons of oil in 100 gallons of water per acre. **Note:** Powdery Mildew:

Initiate sprays at early leaf stage. Continue sprays every 10–14 days. Mite control will be effective under the same spray interval as

powdery mildew sprays. Discontinue sprays at Burr development.

If the label covers the use that is listed on the SLN, then we do need to cancel.
