Enclosed is revised labeling for Washington Special Local Need (SLN) registration number WA-000017 issued to Syngenta Crop Protection for the use of Fulfill[®] Insecticide (EPA Reg. No. 100-912) for control of certain aphids (green peach aphid, pea aphid, cabbage aphid, turnip aphid, and potato aphid) on various vegetable crops (arugula, beet, broccoli raab, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, carrot, cauliflower, Chinese cabbage, Chinese kale, Chinese mustard, collard, endive, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce, mustard, parsley, parsnip, radish (other than daikon), rape, rutabaga, spinach, spinach mustard, Swiss chard, and turnip grown for seed. This registration was issued under authority of Section 24(c) FIFRA.

Revisions include:

- Update the structure of the label
- Added section headers
- Update to the Washington State container disposal statement
- Update to the chemigation statement
- Clarified method of application
- Update the crops grown for seed restrictive language
- Updated maximum application rate to define the annual application rate
- Added a Restricted Entry Interval
- Update to the expiration statement and date (December 31, 2015)
- Update to the label revision date
