Enclosed is Washington Special Local Need (SLN) registration number WA-100001 issued to Bayer CropScience LP for the use of SEVIN® brand 4F Carbaryl Insecticide (EPA Reg. No. 264-349) for control of ghost and mud shrimp in oyster beds. This registration was issued under authority of Section 24(c) FIFRA.

This SLN registration is being issued as a replacement for Bayer CropScience LP SEVIN® 80 Solupak [EPA Reg. No. 264-316 (WA-900013)]. The SEVIN® 80 Solupak is no longer in production.

Efficacy, and residue data to support the use SEVIN® brand 4F Carbaryl Insecticide for control of ghost and mud shrimp in oyster beds has been submitted for the original WA SLN No. WA-900013. Application timing, and use restrictions to protect non-target organisms on the label for WA-100001 are identical to WA-900013.

Revisions include:

- Addition of method of application
- Update the structure of the label
- Update to the Expiration Statement and date to December 31, 2012
- Update of Washington State container disposal statement
- Update to the label revision date
- Adjustments to the label according to the different products
